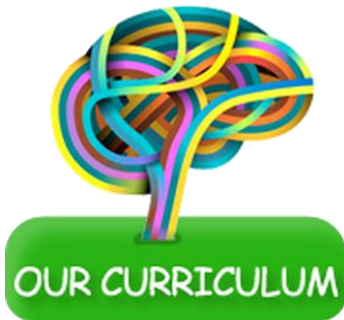

Year 6 World War II Afternoon Tea Monday 27th January 2025 at 3.45pm



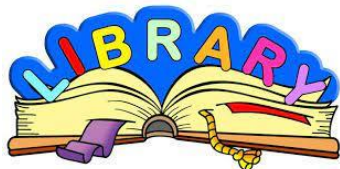
Year 6 parents are invited to a 'World War II style', Afternoon Tea, commencing at 3.45pm in the school hall on Monday 27th January 2025.

Year 6 Residential to Petty Pool Monday 12th to Wednesday 14th May 2025



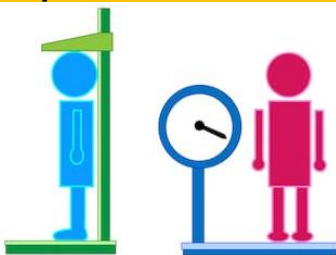
Year 6 will be attending Petty Pool Outdoor Centre in Cheshire between Monday 12th to Wednesday 14th May 2025.

For the NCMP screening, children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils.

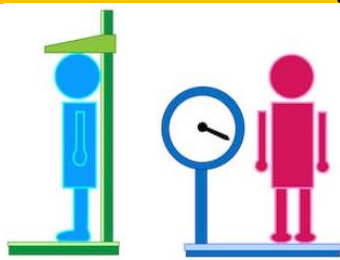

Parking & Driving Around School



To help keep all members of our school community and our wider community safe please remember not to park on the zig-zag lines outside school when dropping off or picking up children and to aid visibility please avoid parking on the road directly outside school. We would also ask any parents using Warwick Drive to be extra careful and aware of pedestrians using this route to access school.

It would also be much appreciated if parents consider the through traffic along Caldry Road and avoid attempting U-turns in the road. These sorts of manoeuvres in the road can be particularly dangerous for all road users and pedestrians during these busy times of day.

Scooters and Bicycles



It is lovely to see children coming to school on their bicycles and scooters in the morning. However please could we ask that bicycles and scooters are not left on the school ground during the day for safety reasons.

Earrings in School



It has come to our attention that there are a number of children wearing earrings in school. Our uniform policy states that for health and safety reasons no jewellery with the exception of a watch may be worn in school.

Therefore, we would be grateful if you could remind children to remove earrings and any other jewellery before coming to school.

We understand that a number of children have only recently had their ears pierced and although it is not ideal, in this instance could we ask parents/carers to ensure that earrings are covered each morning with plasters.

Once the 6-week healing process is complete the earrings should be removed and not worn during school time.

Start of the Day Arrangements
