#### Reception to Year 6 Flu Immunisation – E-consent Friday 12<sup>th</sup> November



Wirral NHS will be offering all children from reception to year 6 a flu nasal spray immunisation on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> November, in school. Parents who wish for their child to have the immunisation must complete an online consent form.

You can now provide electronic-consent (e-Consent) for **all** your child's vaccinations with a click of a button, using your mobile phone, computer, laptop or tablet.

#### So how does the process work?

- the form is simple and easy to complete
- once you've completed the form click 'submit'
- you'll receive an email to confirm the form has been received securely
- the Trust's Immunisation Team will receive your child's form via a secure portal
- if you've consented, your child will have their vaccine in school.

#### Start of Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.


#### End of the School Day
