## Re. Admission to Secondary School – September 2023

Dear parents,

Following registration of your child for the entrance examinations for the Wirral schools (Caldy, West Kirby and Wirral Grammars), the authority have sent a leaflet to familiarise the children with the appearance of the assessment and how to answer the questions on the answer sheet. Although you will already have seen this before, the authority have sent hard copies for the children and they will be coming home shortly.

In addition to this, children will also receive an ID form which will need to be completed. The test centre will require proof of ID for your child before they can sit the assessment. You must complete the Assessment ID form and attach a passport-style photograph that will need to be verified by our school office to receive an official stamp. Children **must** bring this form with them on the assessment date and may **not** be permitted to sit the assessment without it. Please ensure that you return this form before the end of the academic year.

A reminder of important dates:

### 31 May 2022

Deadline for Request for Assessment forms to be returned

### September to October 2022

Literature and application forms will be available from the council, from schools and other outlets for Admission in 2023. The online application system goes live on 1 September.

### 19 September 2022

All children will take the assessment at a test centre. We will require proof of ID for your child before they can be assessed.

The assessment comprises two papers taken on the same day. The assessment date will be 19 September 2022. The assessments will be provided by GL Assessment and will include questions on verbal reasoning, non-verbal reasoning, and mathematics.
