Year 4 Food/Cookery Lessons



As part of the Year 4 Art & Design lessons during this half term the children will be completing cooking lessons with the aim to encourage the children to develop cooking methods, skills, and techniques and understanding of ingredients from different countries in Europe. The children will be focusing on creating dishes from some countries in the Mediterranean. All ingredients will be provided by school and of course all allergies will be catered for.

The Year 4 cooking lessons commenced on Friday 14th January and will continue each Friday thereafter until Friday 4th February. The children will be bringing home the dishes they have prepared to share with their family. In order for the children to bring home the food they have prepared, we would be most grateful if parents/carers could provide a tub with a lid each Friday.

We hope that the children will learn some useful lifelong skills which can be put to use when helping out at home and later in life.

Year 6 Food/Cookery Lessons



As part of the Year 6 Art & Design lessons during this half term the children will be completing some food tasting and cooking lessons with the aim to encourage the children to develop cooking methods, skills, and techniques from Africa, as well as learning about the ingredients and dishes from this continent. All ingredients will be provided by school and of course all allergies will be catered for.

The Year 6 food lessons commenced on Thursday 13th January, when they will start by tasting ingredients that are grown in Africa (avocado, sweet potato, pomegranate juice, Sharon fruit and butternut squash). The following two lessons will include making an African snack (Thursday 20th January) and creating an African dish (Thursday 27th January). The children will be bringing home the snack and dish they have prepared to share with their family. In order for the children to bring home the food they have prepared we

would be most grateful if parents/carers could provide a tub with a lid each Thursday.

We hope that the children will learn some useful lifelong skills which can be put to use when helping out at home and later in life.

IMPORTANT REMINDER Breaktime Snack



We have a number of children in Avalon School with severe allergies. It is vitally important to ensure the health and safety of all the children that only fruit and vegetables are brought into school for break time snacks.

We have also noticed recently that children are bringing in break time snacks to school which are high in salt, sugar and fat such as salted popcorn, crisps, and other sugary snacks. These snacks are not appropriate to brought into school.

Arriving Late to School



For safeguarding purposes, can we please remind parents that if your child is going to be late for school, that you bring your child to the school office so we can ensure that your child has been signed in.

Start of the Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.


End of the School Day
