# Supervision at the end of the school day

Please could we ask that parents / carers ensure that children are safely supervised once they have been dismissed by school staff. There have been some recent incidents where children have wandered away from parents/carers and had an accident or behaved inappropriately with others.

### **Internet Safety**

You may be aware of the recent media interest in a worrying online challenge called Momo. The 'Momo Challenge' and other similar 'crazes' are targeting young children, as young as 6, through pop ups on apps that would usually be deemed harmless by many adults including YouTube and WhatsApp. Further to our recent 'Share Aware' online safety assembly at school, we strongly recommend and remind parents to closely monitor children's

internet use and reiterate the guidance that we give to our children about what to do if they see anything online that worries or upsets them.

We will continue to encourage and remind the children that if they see anything that upsets\scares them, then they are to do what they have always been taught to do and that is to tell a parent\teacher\carer ASAP. If they have seen it on a social media site then they must tell, report and block. If it is sent to them over a messaging app then they must tell, delete and NEVER UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES send it on.

Our children are taught about digital resilience and we regularly speak to them, at an age appropriate level, about their online life. They know that the World Wide Web contains many things that are inappropriate, harmful and scary and they also know that in order to continue an online presence, they will have to learn how to address such things.

Guidance for parents is:

- Ensure they know what their children can access online
- Ensure children understand the importance of not giving personal information to anyone they do not know
- Tell their children no-one has the right to make them do anything they do not want to do
- Use parental controls to keep children safe
