Dear Year 6 parents and carers,



Year 6 Fun Day Friday 5th July

On Friday 5th July, Year 6 will be having their Fun Day at West Kirby beach. We will leave school early - at about 9:30 - in the morning. We will walk from school down the promenade, to the West Kirby beach where we will play some games and have a sand structure building competition. High tide will be at about 11:50 am: we will allow the children to paddle but not swim.

The children should bring a change of clothing, including trainers and socks and a towel in a separate bag. These bags will be taken to the beach in a staff car so that the children can get dry and changed after paddling in the water. They will need a carrier bag to put any wet clothes in.

From the beach, we will go to the Ashton Park playground where we will have our packed lunches and the children will play on the equipment. Then, we will play games on one of the field areas in the park before returning to school at approximately 3:15 in time for dismissal at 3:40pm.

On our Beach Day, the children will wear non-uniform clothes and trainers, suitable for the weather conditions on the day and the walk to the beach and back. They should bring a small backpack with a water bottle, their packed lunch and footwear suitable for the beach. A bucket and spade would be useful, but your child will need to be able to carry all their own equipment. The children will not need their school bags.

For this day, the children can bring their own packed lunch (in a named bag) but please ensure that everything is nut and seed free and no fizzy drinks, please. (Please inform Mrs Kililiku by Monday 1st July via email if you would prefer school to provide a packed lunch for your child.)

Should you want your child to have an ice cream or ice lolly, please provide them with £4. As always, the safety of the children is paramount, and the trip will be fully risk assessed. The Lifeguards are aware that we are visiting the beach and there will be four members of the Avalon staff on the trip, including a Designated First Aider. Please ensure that the School Office is informed, prior to the trip, if there are any updates to your child's medical needs.

Should any parent not want their child to participate, please inform the School Office before by Monday 1st July. Should you have any further questions, please do get in touch.
