Dear Parents/Carers,

Attached are the details regarding clubs for the spring term for Year 3 to Year 6. Please take the time to help your children think carefully about the clubs they would like to do as they will need to commit to the club for the full term. If there is not sufficient interest in a club, unfortunately, the club will not be able to run.

To enable the smooth and safe running of the clubs, we may have to place a limit on the number of children attending. If a club is over-subscribed, children will be allocated places following the drawing of names randomly. Children who are not allocated places will be put on a reserve list.

If you have not heard from us, please assume that your child has a place at the club.

Unless stated clubs will begin on Monday 13th January 2020.

Mandarin Chinese, please do not send any payment until we have confirmed your child's place. Once we have confirmed your child's place (by Monday 13th January), payment should be sent directly into school. This club will begin on **Monday 20th January**.

For any clubs run by an external provider with the exception of the Inventors Club, parents will need to complete a sign up sheet attached. Completed sign up sheets are to be returned to the school office.

Children attending clubs may bring an additional healthy snack and drink which they can have before their club begins.

Children will need full PE kit for sporting clubs and, in line with our school policy, cannot take part in activities without it.

Club information

Mandarin Chinese lessons - Hello, my name is Dan Owen. Both of my two Children Cynan and Sian really enjoy the school life at Avalon. I grew up in China, so Mandarin is my first language. Before I came to the UK, I was lecturing English at a college. I have been working at the University of Liverpool since 2006. In terms of Mandarin teaching, I have been teaching some of my senior colleagues at work. I also have experience of teaching young children. As a member of Avalon PTA, I have volunteered to teach Mandarin as one of the after-school club activity choices. All the fees will go to PTA fund for new school iPads. Please encourage your little ones to spend the "fun Mandarin time" with me. It won't be long that they will outsmart you when you talk about China with them. If you are lucky, they might teach you one or two words at home! The charge for these sessions will be £3 per week and Mrs Owen is kindly donating all money to the PTA fund. Maximum 12 children per group Mondays: 20th January to 30th March – (£27 per child)

Taekwondo – Taekwondo classes help children gain more self-confidence & focus, enhance their coordination skills, improve fitness levels, help promote good behaviour and are conducted in a safe, disciplined & professional manner. Jason Rodd from the Jason Rodd School of Taekwondo https://www.taekwondo.gb.net/ will be coming in to Avalon to teach a series of after school sessions on a Tuesday Times: 3:40pm - 4:40pm £4 per child (maximum of 20) for the junior class. Spaces are reserved on a first come, first serve basis. Children will need their school PE kit for these clubs. Tuesdays: 14th January to 31st March (10 weeks £40 per child)

Inventors club - Inventors club is a project which was founded in Portugal and is designed to inspire children's exploration and creative thinking skills. The club will run over 10 weeks and each week children will explore a range of areas including engineering, problem solving, designing and creativity. They will work with individual kits which they will get to take home at the end of the session and some weeks the children will work in groups on a larger scale project. Activities may include designing and making a double light sabre, a pinball game, an earthquake simulator and a catapult, plus many more! Tuesdays: 14th January to 31st March - 3:40pm-4:40pm (10 weeks £35.75 per child)

Fast and Curious




