

Year 5 Bikeability Course Level 1&2

Tuesday 8th, Wednesday 9th & Thursday 10th October 2024





The children who are taking part in the Bikeability Course have now been allocated their day. We are sure all the children are looking forward to getting on their bikes and learning to ride with new confidence.

The Course will take place in the school playground and on local roads near to the school. The instructors will carry out a risk assessment of the training areas before the start of the course. A copy of the risk assessment will be available at the school.

On the day your child:

Must wear a cycle belmet

Must wear a cycle helmet

Must have appropriate clothing. Children should come to school on the course days in their full PE kit with their outdoor school coats. They must make sure they have long trousers and gloves in case the weather is cold.

Must have a bike which is road worthy

Your child's bike should be brought to school on the morning of their course and taken home at the end of the day. On arrival at the school, bikes should be taken to the area outside the Site Manager's (Bill) room, by the main office. If this causes any significant challenge for any parent, please let us know as soon as possible.

Year 4 Visit to the World Museum Tuesday 8th October 2024



As part of the Humanities and English cross-curricular topic 'Ancient Egyptians', an educational visit to Liverpool World Museum has been booked for the children in Year 4 on Tuesday 8th October. We hope the visit to the Egyptology floor will enhance the children's learning about what life was like in Ancient Egypt.

The cost of the trip will be £15.50 which will include the cost of train tickets and entrance to the workshop.

Children will be travelling by car from Avalon School to Bidston Park. From Bidston Park and Ride, the children will take a train to Liverpool

Lime Street and then a short walk to the museum. Children will arrive back at school for approximately 3.00pm.

School uniform must be worn, including blazers but not school hats. There will be no need for the children to bring any spending money. A packed lunch will be provided.

As part of the Year 6 religious education topics of Judaism and Christianity, an educational visit to Allerton Synagogue and St George's Church Liverpool has been booked on Wednesday 9th October 2024. 

Start of the Day Arrangements

Late attendance (after 8.45am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.




