The cost of the trip will be £12.50 which will include the cost of the coach and entry to the planetarium at the museum. We will set off from school at approximately 10.30am.

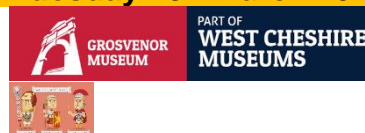
We will depart from the museum at approximately 2.15pm and will back in time for normal pick up.

Year 3 Visit to the Roman Soldier Tour at Grosvenor Museum Chester Tuesday 25th March 2025



A visit to The Roman Soldier Tour at The Grosvenor Museum in Chester has been booked for Year 3 children for Tuesday 25th March 2025. This trip promises to be an enriching experience, offering valuable insights into history, art, and cultural heritage of the Romans.

The cost of the trip will be £30.65 per child, which includes transportation, entry fees to the museum, time in the museum to explore both galleries as well as a Roman Soldier tour to the Amphitheatre. Children will be travelling to the Museum by coach and leaving at approximately 9:15am. Please ensure your child arrives to school in plenty of time so we can organise ourselves for departure. 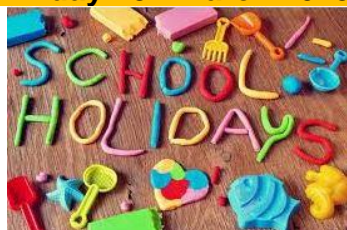

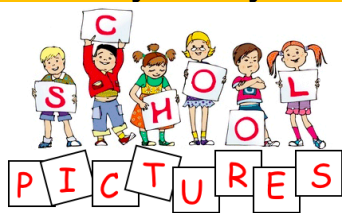


School will be closed the Easter Holidays from Monday 31st March until Monday 14th April inclusive.

Pre-School Transfer to Reception September 2025



Following on from the "Take a Look" event of Friday 7th March 2025, we would like to write to you about next steps and the arrangements for children transferring from our Pre-School to our Reception class in September 2025.

In allocating places in our Reception class, we always give priority to our current children in the Pre School first. We would therefore like to share our offer for Reception provision with you to assist you with making a fully informed and rounded decision about the next steps for your child's educational journey.

Our current Pre-schoolers have already enjoyed some exploratory visits to the Reception classroom and started to meet the Reception staff team. We would now like to extend this welcome by offering some informal, introductory sessions for parents to meet with Mrs Callaway, Headteacher, Mrs Daniel, our Reception teacher, and to discuss more about what we can offer your child in September 2025.

If you would like to take up this opportunity for an individual appointment, please confirm this with your child's key worker in Pre School and we will be happy to arrange that with you.

We have already had a number of enquiries and statements of interest in next year's Reception class from external parents and we will soon be confirming them as secured places for September 2025.

We shall, therefore, hold provisional places for all of our current Pre-School children until Tuesday 15th April 2025. If you wish to confirm your child(ren)'s place(s) in Reception for September 2025, we would be grateful if you would complete and return the reply slip by the above date.

We ask parents who wish to reserve their child(ren)'s place(s) in Reception class September 2025 to sign and complete the school's registration form and agreement of the school's terms and conditions.

To help keep all members of our school community and our wider community safe please remember not to park on the zig-zag lines outside school when dropping off or picking up children and to aid visibility please avoid parking on the road directly outside school. It would also be much appreciated if parents consider the through traffic along Caldry Road and avoid attempting U-turns in the road. These sorts of manoeuvres in the road can be particularly dangerous for all road users and pedestrians during these busy times of day.

Earrings in School



It has come to our attention that there are a number of children wearing earrings in school. Our uniform policy states that for health and safety reasons no jewellery with the exception of a watch may be worn in school.

Therefore, we would be grateful if you could remind children to remove earrings and any other jewellery before coming to school.

We understand that a number of children have only recently had their ears pierced and although it is not ideal, in this instance could we ask parents/carers to ensure that earrings are covered each morning with plasters.

Once the 6-week healing process is complete the earrings should be removed and not worn during school time.

Late attendance (after 8.45am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.

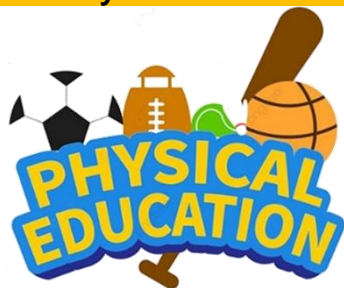

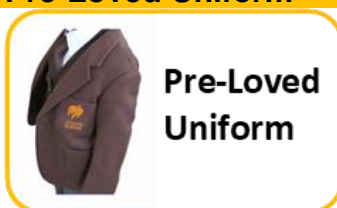
