



#### **Sibling Drop Off and Collection**




Staggered bubble group drop off and collection times are in place during drop off and collection to help reduce the risks of transmission of COVID-19.

Late collections for any children (including Nursery and Pre-School Wraparound) will incur an additional charge.

The routines and procedures for dropping off at Before School Club and collecting from After School Club will continue as the autumn term arrangements. On arrival, please press the buzzer at the gate for assistances, your child(ren) will then be brought down to meet you at the gate.
