
We are appreciative of all feedback and very much want to work in partnership with our parents' views on such an important aspect of our curriculum.

# Science Week Reception to Year 6 Week Commencing Monday 24th May



During the week beginning Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May, Avalon will be celebrating Science Week.

All children from Reception to Year 6 will be taking part in their own exciting scientific enquiries throughout the week, leading up to a Science Fair on Friday afternoon, all linked to the topic of 'Innovation for the Future'.

Within the topic 'Innovation for the Future' the children will be focusing on the following areas:

- Reception Growth and Change
- Year 1 and Year 2 Food
- Year 3 and Year 4 Clothes
- Year 5 and Year 6 Energy


To begin with, the children will discover what the words 'innovation' and 'invention' mean. They will be provided with a Special Inventor's Box that will encase clues and ideas on what their enquiry will be based on.

Continuing on through the week, from their own discussion and research, they will create an enquiry question to investigate linked to their focus above and using the range of resources available. Each class will be given time to conduct their investigation, creating an example of their product to test out.

Finally, they will use their new scientific understanding and skills to produce a presentation on their findings and conclusions, that will be displayed for the whole school in our Avalon Science Fair.

We are sure that the children will bring energy and enthusiasm to each part of this exciting week and conclude with a sense of achievement and new scientific knowledge.

### **Arrangements for the Summer Term 2021**



The Department for Education updated its operational guidance for Schools on 26<sup>th</sup> March. Arrangements at Avalon for the summer term will continue to follow the DfE guidance.

- Drop Off and Collection arrangements will continue to be staggered in the same way as they have been during the Spring Term, until further notice.
- Children will wear their Summer Uniform as normal, with the exception of PE days, when they should come to school in their PE kits to avoid changing in school.
- Children will continue to be in distinct 'bubble groups' wherever possible, to reduce the risk of transmission.
- School will continue to follow the system of controls as advised by Public Health England
- Educational day visits may resume following 12<sup>th</sup> April, subject to stringent risk assessment, however residential visits are not currently permissible.
- Wraparound & Before & After School Club (Childcare) will continue to run with same timings as in the Spring term. (8am-8.30am and 3pm to 5.30pm)
- Parents are not permitted to enter the school site, unless by prior arrangement by appointment.

Further details will be confirmed to parents prior to the start of term (Updated Parent Handbook) all arrangements are subject to change.

# Safer Road Watch Team



The Safer Road Watch Team has been in touch with School regarding their concerns over the speed of car along Caldy Road and the safety implications involved. We have been asked to make our whole school community aware that a group of vetted volunteers will shortly be issued with handheld speed radar guns and will be operating speed checks along Caldy Road. The group is hoping to establish a 20mph speed limit for Caldy Road, something that we have been campaigning for too.

# **Sibling Drop Off and Collection**




Staggered bubble group drop off and collection times are in place during drop off and collection to help reduce the risks of transmission of COVID-19.
