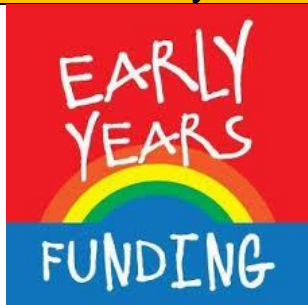
February Half Term Monday 15th to Friday 19th February

After School provision will be available on Friday 12th February until 5pm.

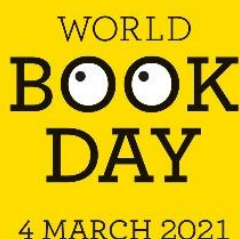
Early Year Funding Forms Deadline – Friday 26th February

World Book Day Thursday 4th March 2021

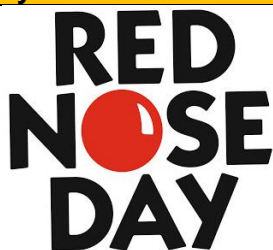

Early Year 30 Hour Funding Eligibility Code for the Summer Term Deadline – 31st March 2021



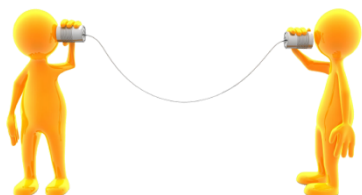

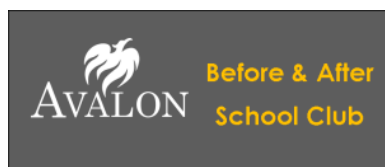
Lines of Communication
