You can now provide electronic-consent (e-Consent) for **all** your child's vaccinations with a click of a button, using your mobile phone, computer, laptop or tablet.

#### So how does the process work?

- the form is simple and easy to complete
- once you've completed the form click 'submit'
- you'll receive an email to confirm the form has been received securely
- the Trust's Immunisation Team will receive your child's form via a secure portal
- if you've consented, your child will have their vaccine in school.

As we have done in previous years and as part of our maths curriculum, children from Reception to Year 6 will be able to access the Mathletics website using their unique code.

Mathletics offers a fun and interactive format to motivate children. Both 'practice in the curriculum' and 'Live Mathletics', used regularly, can consolidate learning. In order for children to benefit the most from the program, it is recommended that children use it for up to 1 hour each week. It is also recommended that this is done in short 20 minute bursts rather than prolonged usage. School staff will be monitoring usage and have the ability to send motivational messages to the children.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.


