Infants (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) Nativity Tuesday 7th December

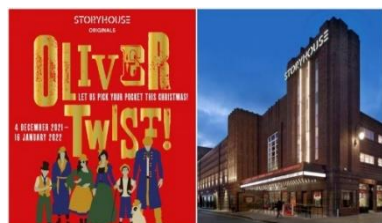

Whole School Celebration at St Bridgets

We warmly invite you to join us for a Christmas Celebration Service on the last morning of term, Tuesday 14th December at 11.30am. Please note that Avalon School will not have access to St Bridget's Church until 11.15am as there is another event prior.

Staff will escort children in Reception to Year 6 to church and they should arrive at school, at the normal time. Children will need their school blazers and an extra layer of clothing under their normal school uniform as it can be a little cold in church. Children in Nursery and Pre-School will continue with their normal routine at school.

Due to limited space at St Bridget's Church and to ensure the safety of all the children, staff and parents we are asking that **only 1 parents/carers per family attends the Christmas Celebration Service** so that we can ensure a more comfortable, COVID safe experience for everyone involved.

At the time of writing, although not mandatory for adults or children to wear face masks, we kindly ask and encourage all adults to wear a face covering (unless exempt) in Church, as it is an enclosed environment and larger gathering. We advise parents and carers to take a rapid lateral flow test prior to attending the event. You can order tests [online](#) or visit a pharmacy. If your test is positive, you should isolate immediately and [get a PCR test](#).

We would kindly ask that you send in a small new toy, gift or sweets, with your child. Gifts should be left unwrapped. The gifts will be placed at the front of church during the service, to support and help underprivileged children have a happier Christmas.

After the service the gifts will be transported to the Charles Thompson Mission in Birkenhead to help them with their charitable work. The Mission will pass the gifts on to where they are most needed. They will match the present to children of the right age and gender and then wrap them before delivery.

If you wish to collect your child(ren) from the church service, please indicate on the slip below. Otherwise, staff will escort the children back to school, for the earlier finishing time of 12.30pm. **Please note that the After School Club service will not be available on this day.**

Start of Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.

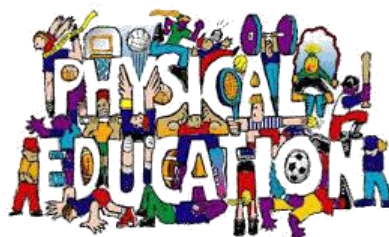
