

## Extra-curricular Clubs Spring Term 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,



Attached are the details regarding extra-curricular clubs for the Spring Term 2022. Please take the time to help your child(ren) think carefully about the clubs they would like to do as they will need to commit to the club for the full term. If there is not sufficient interest in a club, unfortunately, the club will not be able to run.

As with many arrangements in the current climate, they are all subject to change. This may be following government guidance or similar. We are hoping to keep our clubs running and open but we ask that parents understand that we may need to make amendments to them, even at a short notice. Changes will be communicated via the weekly newsletter.

To enable the smooth and safe running of the clubs, we may have to place a limit on the number of children attending. If a club is over-subscribed children will be allocated places not on a first come first served basis but following the drawing of names randomly. Children who are not allocated places will be offered a place on a reserve list. In the summer term, children who are on the waiting list will have first refusal for a place if that club is continuing to run.

Online forms should be completed by 6pm on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January and we will confirm places in a club by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January. Clubs will begin on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January.

Children attending clubs running after school may bring an additional healthy snack which they can have before their club begins.

Children will need full PE kit for sporting clubs and, in line with our school policy, cannot take part in activities without it.

## Clubs Information

**Verbal Reasoning sessions** Girls and boys in Year 5 who are wishing to sit for Upton Hall or St Anselm's must sit NFER tests in Verbal Reasoning. The entrance exam for St Anselm's for boys also consists of three written papers (VR, Maths & English) and a mental maths paper. With this in mind, Mr Ashton will be running after school sessions teaching the skills of verbal reasoning which are likely to appear on these two assessments and are therefore aimed at boys and girls who are wishing to sit these exams. This is being run alongside the timetabled preparation for the assessments within curriculum time.

**Tinkercad** - Tinkercad is a free, easy-to-use web app that equips the next generation of designers and engineers with the foundational skills for innovation: 3D design, electronics, and coding! This is a lunchtime club.

**STEAM Club** STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Maths) Club is a session that enriches and broadens the curriculum, giving young people the chance to explore subjects like science, technology, engineering, art and maths in less formal settings. In our STEAM club, we will be igniting interest and imagination in these subjects by having a go at activities that involve looking at chemical reactions, making moving objects and building bridges out of a range of materials.

**French** – learn new words and phrases in French with Mrs McGregor. Fun and games and picking new skills along the way!

**Construction club** – This club is for all you infant builders who want to create wonderful constructions in Lego, Meccano and other building materials. We are on the lookout for any donations of Lego from our parent community that will help build up our collection.

**Performing Arts (Joseph and His Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat)** – This club is open to children in Year 6 who wish to be part of a short performance of "Joseph". This is not a replacement for the summer performance but is being run in addition. As the club progresses, other year groups may be invited to join in.

**Oliver!** - This will be by invite via the weekly newsletter. Each week will feature a different part. Children who wish to do netball alongside this can sign up for both.

**Netball club** – we will be building the skills of netball through small sided games, drills and practices. We will look at the skills through high 5 games and full sided games.
