Year 6 Food/Cookery Lessons




As part of the Year 6 Art & Design lessons during this half term the children will be completing some food tasting and cooking lessons with the aim to encourage the children to develop cooking methods, skills, and techniques from Africa, as well as learning about the ingredients and dishes from this continent. All ingredients will be provided by school and of course all allergies will be catered for.

The Year 6 food lessons commenced on Thursday 13th January, when they will start by tasting ingredients that are grown in Africa (avocado, sweet potato, pomegranate juice, Sharon fruit and butternut squash). The following two lessons will include making an African snack (Thursday 20th January) and creating an African dish (Thursday 27th January). The children will be bringing home the snack and dish they have prepared to share with their family. In order for the children to bring home the food they have prepared we would be most grateful if parents/carers could provide a tub with a lid each Thursday.

We hope that the children will learn some useful lifelong skills which can be put to use when helping out at home and later in life.

Reception Class Height and Weight Screening



Following the successful introduction of the immunisation e-consent process Wirral Community Health and Care NHS Foundation Trust are delighted to continue this approach regarding the **OPT OUT** consent for the NCMP and School Age Screening service.

There are main advantages to moving to electronic forms:

- the process of giving consent will be much easier and quicker for parents, carers and schools
- reduced risk of forms going missing/not reaching parents
- the process is completely safe, secure and convenient, saving both paper and time
- the school will no longer be required to process paper consent forms on behalf of Wirral Community Health and Care NHS Foundation Trust. All information will be captured directly by the Trust in electronic form.

Year 5 Class Assembly Monday 14th February 2022

Due to limited space and to ensure the safety of all the children, staff and parents, we will utilise the following measures:

- Windows and doors will be open during the event to ventilate and improve the air flow in the school hall whilst the event takes place. (You may wish to wear some additional layers of clothing, as the temperature in the Hall may be lower than usual)
- We kindly ask parents / carers to wear a face mask in the school hall communal area (unless exempt). We will make sure that we have some available, should anyone forget to bring one.
- We advise parents and carers to take a rapid lateral flow test prior to attending the event. You can order tests <u>online</u> or visit a pharmacy. If your test is positive, you should isolate immediately and follow the latest government guidance.
- Please make use of the hand sanitiser on entry and exit from the school hall.
- Entry and exit to the school hall will be via the double doors at the side of the hall, which should be accessed via the Astro turfed playground.
- Doors will open for parents to be seated at 8.50am.
- To limit movement during the gathering, refreshments will not be made available on this occasion.

Should the local COVID case rates and risk levels increase nearer to the date of the event, or Government guidance change, we reserve the right to put other COVID protective measures and contingencies in place for the safety of everyone involved, or to postpone the event until further notice. The above arrangements are, therefore, subject to change. Any changes will be communicated to parents and carers ahead of the assembly.

IMPORTANT REMINDER Breaktime Snack



We have a number of children in Avalon School with severe allergies. It is vitally important to ensure the health and safety of all the children that only fruit, and vegetables are brought into school for break time snacks.

We have also noticed recently that children are bringing in break time snacks to school which are high in salt, sugar and fat such as salted popcorn, crisps, and other sugary snacks. These snacks are not appropriate to brought into school.

Arriving Late to School



For safeguarding purposes, can we please remind parents that if your child is going to be late for school, that you bring your child to the school office so we can ensure that your child has been signed in.

Start of the Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.


