

Pre-School and Reception Visit to Ness Gardens

Tuesday 3rd May 2022



As part of the Pre-School and Reception class topic about Spring and Growth, an educational visit to Ness Botanic Gardens has been booked on Tuesday 3rd May 2022. We hope the visit to the gardens will enhance the children's learning about caring for our planet and local environment whilst extending their knowledge and understanding of the world.

The cost of the trip will be £15.25 which will include the cost of the coach, entry to the gardens and workshop. The coach, (fitted with seatbelts), will set off from school at approximately 9.30am, please ensure your child arrives to school in plenty of time so we can organise ourselves for departure. 




