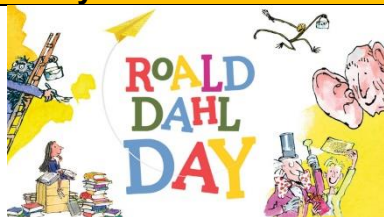
Macmillan Coffee Morning – SAVE THE DATE

Assessment & Monitoring



Children in Reception to Year 6 are commencing the InCAS assessments which helps to provide us with age-related diagnostics information and recommendations for each child, where required. The children will be undertaking these computer-based assessment modules over the next few weeks.

Year 6 History Topic – WW2



In history this term, Year 6 are learning about World War 2. They have already embraced the new topic and are full of enthusiasm which is lovely to see. We would like to make a display of photos to show the children how we all have connections from that period; World War 2 and indeed to History. We appreciate that if you do have any family photos or memorabilia, they will be precious, so we would kindly ask that you could perhaps take some photos of photos, or any war related items that are personal to your family. Late attendance (after 8.45am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.

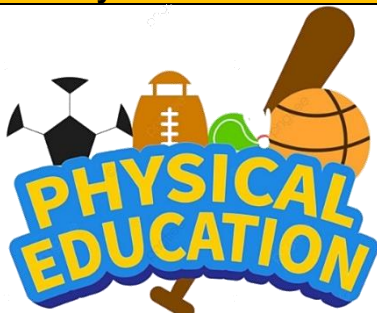

IMPORTANT REMINDER Breaktime Snacks

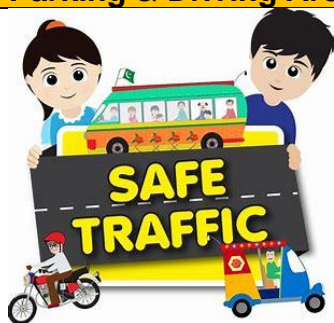
