All children should come to school in their House T Shirt and trainers or pumps. Should girls like to, they can wear black or brown shorts. As we cannot forecast the weather conditions for Wednesday, please put appropriate extra clothing, such as a school tracksuit and waterproof jacket in a bag (such as a small rucksack) for your child.
