



Year 6 Grammar School Assessment Arrangements Monday 18th September and Friday 22nd September 2023



Entrance examinations for Wirral grammar schools take place on Monday 18th September, and for St Anselm's College on Friday 22nd September.

If your child is sitting in the afternoon, it will be up to parents' discretion if your child attends school in the morning. Similarly, if your child's sitting is in the morning, it will be up to parents if they return to school in the afternoon.

If your child is not sitting an entrance exam on a particular day, it is expected that your child will be in school as normal.

Assessment & Monitoring



Children in Reception to Year 6 are continuing their InCAS assessments next week which helps to provide us with age-related diagnostics information and recommendations for each child, where required. The children will be undertaking these computer-based assessment modules over the next few weeks.

Mathletics Reception to Year 6



As we have done in previous years and as part of our maths curriculum, children from Reception to Year 6 will be able to access the Mathletics website using their unique code.

We will put a reminder of your child's unique log on details in the form of a sticker, into your child's reading record (infants) or diary (juniors).

Earrings in School



It has come to our attention that there are a number of children wearing earrings in school. Our uniform policy states that for health and safety reasons no jewellery with the exception of a watch may be worn in school.

Therefore, we would be grateful if you could remind children to remove earrings and any other jewellery before coming to school.

We understand that a number of children have only recently had their ears pierced and although it is not ideal, in this instance could we ask parents/carers to ensure that earrings are covered each morning with plasters.

Once the 6-week healing process is complete the earrings should be removed and not worn during school time.

Late attendance (after 8.45am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.


