**Year 5 Space Food Picnic  
Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2017**

As part of the 'Space' topic, Year 5 will be learning about Space food from the 1960's to 2017. They will learn how and why food is specially prepared for consumption in Space. To enhance their learning, they will also be sampling some freeze dried 'astronaut food'. This will include freeze dried ice cream which was originally developed for the early Apollo missions. Freeze dried ice cream is frozen to -40 degree Celsius and then vacuum dried and placed in a special foil pouch. Children will also sample freeze dried fruit. None of the items **contain** nuts but some may have been produced in a facility that process peanuts and tree nuts.
