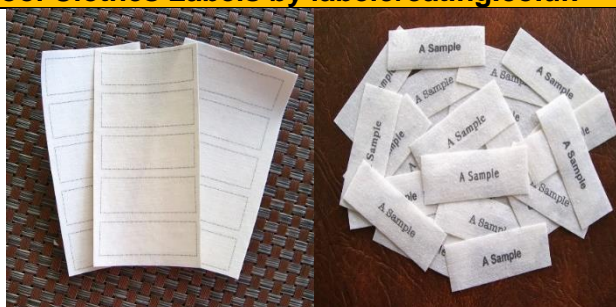
Cancer Research Race for Life – Wirral Pretty Muddy Kids 5K Race Saturday 30th June 2018
