Dear Children & Parents

Below are the details regarding clubs for the Spring term. Please take the time to help your children think carefully about the clubs they would like to do as they will need to commit to the club for the full term. If there is not sufficient interest in a club, unfortunately, the club will not be able to run. To find out more about a particular club, please see the member of staff that is running it.

Drama – Mrs Hamer offers drama lessons from Nursery to Year 6 on **Fridays**. The children also have the opportunity to take LAMDA examinations (The London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art (LAMDA) examination board is internationally acclaimed and has been leading education in performing arts for 150 years) If you would like your child to have drama lessons, please see the attached letter for more information. **Please note that the year 3 session has now moved to 3.40pm**

Reception and Year 1 – lunchtime **Year 2** 3.05 – 3.35 **Years 3-6** 3.40 – 4.30

Ballet – Miss Chapman will be offering sessions to boys and girls from Preschool (aged 3 and 4) up to Year 2 (aged 7). The sessions will be £5 for a 30 minute lesson and is payable, in advance, to the school office via cheque (made payable to Becky Chapman) or named envelope of cash. The office staff will pass on your payment to Miss Chapman. If you have any questions about uniform, please contact the school office. **The next block of lessons will be from Tuesday 24th April 2018 and run until Tuesday 3rd July (10 weeks excluding the half term).** Pre school lessons will be from 2pm until 2.30 pm and Reception to Year 2 lessons will be from 2.35 until 3.05. For more information, see the office.

Thinking Skills – It works by having a circuit to complete, all designed to get your brain going. There will be up to ten stations where pupils work in pairs to complete an activity in 2-3 minutes. To begin with the stations consist of; Solitaire, Clock card game, Pontoon card game, Scrabble, vocab card game, thesaurus game, maths puzzle, memory game, NVR puzzles and Jigsaws. They will all change weekly. Activities build on links between areas of learning and recognising patterns. Children are encouraged to try their hardest and monitor their own progress and try to better themselves week by week.

Judo - Judo education <http://www.judoeducation.co.uk> are coming in to school to work with children from Rec to Y6 and provide all the equipment, the children just need their PE kit. The class will be taught on Judo Mats in full judo kit. The classes can take place after school on Mondays. The infant course (R – Y2) is from 3.05 until 3.35 and the junior class (Y3 – 6) is from 3.40 until 4.40. **The next block of lessons will be from Tuesday 24th April 2018 and run until Tuesday 26th June (9 weeks excluding the half term).** The cost of the 9 week course is £3.50 per lesson (£31.50) for the infants and £7 per lesson (£63) for the juniors. Money should be brought to the school office in a named envelope. All children will receive certificates during the course and at the end of the course. These certificates are in place to help the children strive towards respect, discipline, effort and wanting to achieve.

Hoylake Lawn Tennis Clubs coaching team are back to offer a short coaching course. This course will be fun, educational and a great intro to further tennis. They provide all the equipment but if your child does have a tennis racket feel free to bring to the session.


